Supported Internships help young people aged 16-24 with an Education, Health and Care Plan get into work.



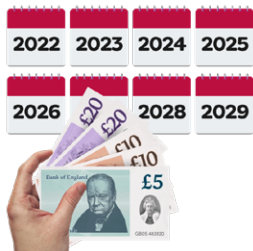
You learn in the workplace.
