What role do Groundworkers play in the Construction & Built Environment Industry?

Groundworkers prepare construction sites by clearing land, setting foundations, installing drainage, and laying pipes. They ensure the site is safe, level, and ready for building. They need to operate machinery, interpret plans, and work closely with other construction professionals to make sure a project runs efficiently. **Find out more here:** You'll use MATHS to calculate areas and volumes, and level ground GEOGRAPHY could also be helpful in understanding soil types and land features Groundworkers love being OUTDOORS... in all weathers!

Get started with a college course, an apprenticeship or by applying directly to an employer Groundworkers can upskill to operate heavy machinery or train in leadership to be a site manager!

You'll need a CSCS card (Construction Skills Certification Scheme) to show you have the right training and safety knowledge to work on a building site.
